
## STUDENTS OF THE WORD

The **curriculum** used at FCS is all based upon the Bible. Studying the earth and its elements? At FCS you'll learn how God created it all. Learning about the history of our country? Our students study how **faith and beliefs** have shaped our nation.

When discussing current events, students are encouraged to identify scripture that applies to every day life circumstances. You see, the **Bible** is in everything we do and our students learn to develop a **Christian world view**.

Students also **study the Bible** itself and **memorize scripture**, hiding it in their hearts and allowing it to filter through their minds, will and emotions.

All students, grades k-12, memorize a scripture every week. "Bible" is a class period for all secondary students and part of the daily **curriculum** for all elementary students.







Whether studying a specific book of the Bible, character or topic, the influence is not only on learning **God's Word** but also on **applying Biblical principles** in our lives – living out our faith.

No aspect of the school day escapes the influence of the **Word**, including the training process in correcting behavior or attitudes. If there is an area of weakness, students are asked to memorize scripture that specifically addresses a need to **strengthen** them in that area.

WHETHER IT HAPPENS IN THE CLASSROOM, ON THE PLAYGROUND OR IN THE PRINCIPAL'S OFFICE AND NO MATTER THE TOPIC, OUR STUDENTS ARE **PUPILS OF THE WORD**.

#### STUDENTS OF THE WORD

Weekly chapel services are opportunities for students to worship, pray and hear the Word together. Speakers from area churches bring a message to our students.

Elementary chapels usually include object lessons, games, skits or even a snack to help teach **Bible truths** – ask students about the "V8 Vegetables of the Spirit" that Pastor Anderson is sharing each month! Our local pastors are so caring and creative when they share **God's Word**.











Junior high and high school students were recently challenged by a local pastor to be Old Testament Daniels who will **stand up** against the culture and **profess boldly** their faith and trust in Jesus Christ.

**Worship** music on the secondary campus is led by Lydia Crist, FCS Student Chaplain, and the chapel band consisting of other high school students who take turns sharing their musical talents.

Once a month, chapel services on the junior high and high school campus are dedicated to unity groups for small group **Bible study** led by a teacher or parent volunteer. Coming up in the month of October, students will have an opportunity to share their own testimonies with their peers during chapel time.

Singing together, praying together and listening to leaders speak the **Bible** to them, Faith Christian students are **students of the Word!** 







### STUDENTS OF THE WORD

#### **Retreats**

Special things happen when students and teachers get together outdoors to enjoy God's creation. Throw in some some paintball, ziplining, games, skits, worship, prayer and teaching of the Word and once in a lifetime experiences happen.

Beginning in grade 7, students attend a retreat with their classmates where they get to experience all of these things as they **draw closer** to the Lord and one another. Junior High students go to Wolf Mountain camp for one night while high schoolers attend Sky Mountain for two nights (seniors get an extra night of bonding time). These experiences strengthen the faith of each individual student, but they also unite the student body.

As one student stated, "Sky Mountain is one of the greatest experiences during one's high school years. Everyone got to make memories and really get to know others well. Everyone came back more connected and **united as a family**." Retreats are just one more opportunity for Faith Christian students to be **students of the Word**!
