JOB DESCRIPTION FAITH CHRISTIAN SCHOOL TEACHER

I. General Description

The primary responsibility of the teacher is to promote the Mission/Purpose statement of the school and to serve as a Christian role model for the students. The teacher works directly under the supervision of the campus Principal. He/she is responsible to effectively communicate and Biblically integrate the subject matter in his/her classroom. He/she will maintain a classroom environment that is conducive to learning and demonstrate an ability to work with kids. He/she should take into consideration the individual needs of the students academically, emotionally, and spiritually.

II. Qualifications

The teacher must have a BA degree in the field in which they will have primary instructional responsibilities. Teachers may teach in a minor field upon demonstration of expertise in that field. A California teaching credential is required or must be in progress with a specific written plan as to completion date. Teachers must be committed to Christian education and believe in Faith Christian School's Mission/Purpose statement. He/she must be spiritually mature and active in a local evangelical church that is in harmony with the school's philosophy. Teachers should demonstrate a growing relationship with God.

III. Responsibilities

- 1. Be an effective Christian role model consistent with Biblical principles that include refraining from drugs/alcohol/tobacco, lifestyles of homosexuality, and conduct that is unprofessional.
- 2. Effectively communicate subject matter.
- 3. Integrate Biblical principles into subject matter.
- 4. Prepare systematic plans for instruction on a daily/weekly basis.
- 5. Follow yearly scope, sequence, and general course outline.
- 6. Keep accurate and complete records of students grade and attendance.
- 7. Communicate with the home in a timely and efficient manner.
- 8. Give prompt and careful attention to routine classroom matters (maintenance, equipment, ventilation, cleanliness).
- 9. Maintain discipline and classroom control in accordance with the guidelines of the school.
- 10. Faithfully attend morning devotions and faculty meetings.
- 11. Communicate necessary information to principal, secretaries, and colleagues while committed to unity and teamwork.
- 12. Continually upgrade professional competence by attending workshops, seminars, and coursework.
- 13. Physically be able to handle job responsibilities.
