Dear First Grade Parents,

Welcome to this exciting year in the growth of your child! I'm looking forward to knowing each of you better as we work together this year.

Please put all supplies in a brown grocery bag & label with your child's name. Supplies each child will need are as follows:

- 1 - **NKJV Bible (New King James Bible** – (available at Back to School Night) \$17
* **Please purchase Bible from school.** As we learn to use the Bible on our own, it is extremely helpful if the students have the same Bible.
- 1 - Premier Agenda (available at Back to School Night) - \$10.00
- 2 boxes - #2 pencils – **sharpened** (No decorated pencils please.)
- 2 - Pencil bags – no pencil boxes please!
- 1 - Box of 24 crayons – please label box
- 1 - Box of sharpened colored pencils
- 4 - Glue sticks – purple
- 1 - Ruler for inches and centimeters – **wooden** only – no plastic
- A backpack (no rolling backpacks please)
- 4 - Packs of dry erase markers (please keep markers packaged. Do not label.)
- 2 - Folders – one red, one yellow – plastic with pockets
- 4 - Large containers of baby wipes/wet ones (No Clorox wipes)
- 1 - Box of markers (washable - thin tips)
- 1 - Box of addition and subtraction flashcards #1-12 (available at Walmart, Dollar Store, CVS)
- 1 - Pair of scissors
- 2 - Box of Kleenex
- 1 - Small hand-held pencil sharpener with bin for shavings
- 1 - Box Ziploc gallon bags

Other things may be needed during the school year and will be communicated to you as needed.

We will have a midmorning “Nutrition Break” during which fruit, crackers, cheese, carrot or celery sticks would be acceptable.
